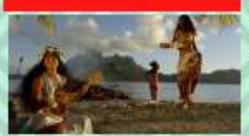
TAHITIAN DANCE

of it because at each dive I discover

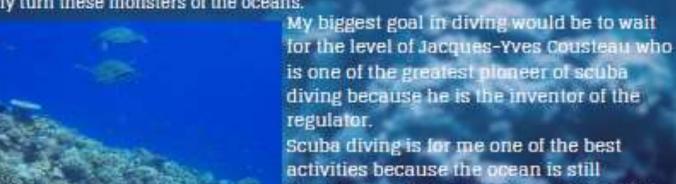
or techniques under water.

USA. It was the most awesome experience I lived in my life. Even though I came back with a silver medal, Jiujitsu remains my greatest puke 1102 passion.



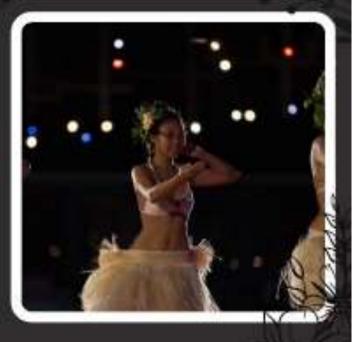
MY PASSIONS - Tevainui Chang

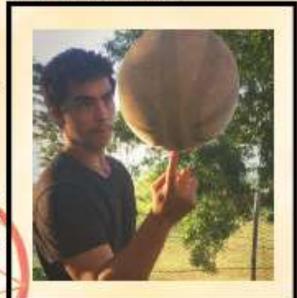

The motorbike has taught me to be careful on the road because since I have been riding I see a lot of people breaking the rules of the road and they are putting lives in danger.

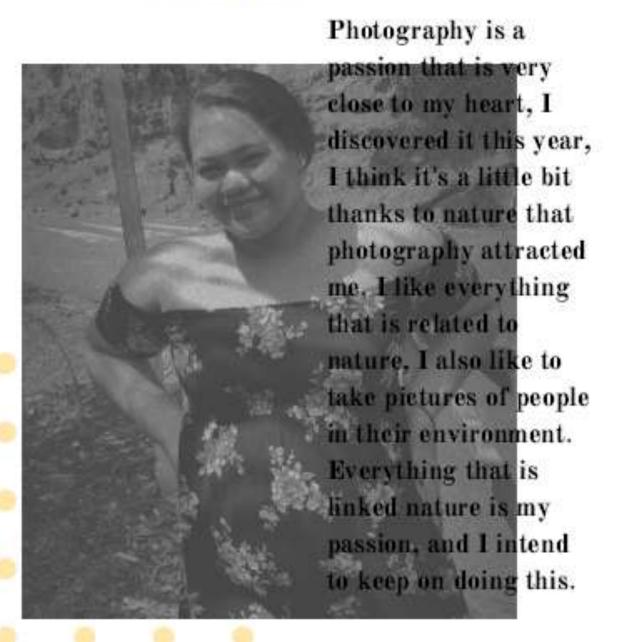
My motorbike has become very dear to me, to the point where no one else can ride it.

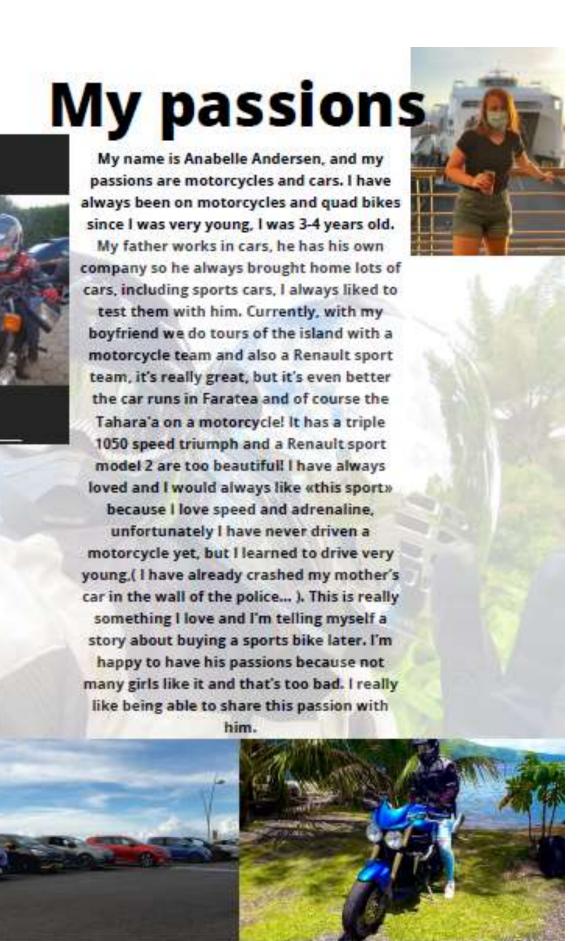
REAL PASSION

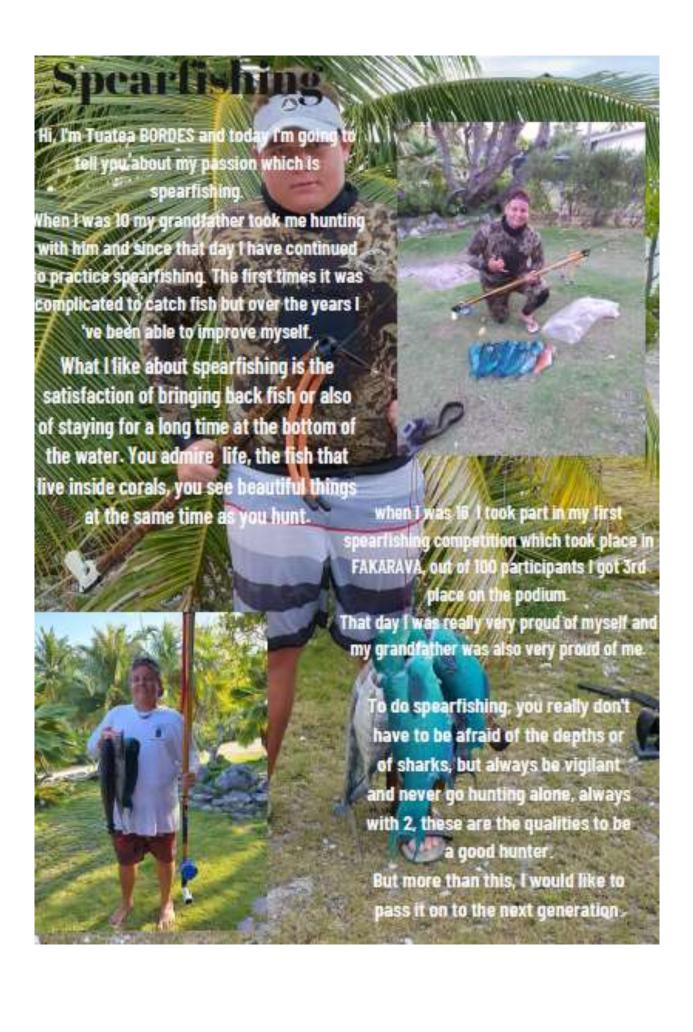

And for that, it's the best way to feel alive. All these things make me love this, but what I like most is to be able to wheel because I get new sensations. It allows me to get adrenaline while putting myself and others at risk.





One of my other passions is Fire dancing. It's a traditional dance used by Samoan warriors.

Nowadays we do competitions like the world fireknife competition in Hawaii. Despite the ability of the dancers, they don't often get burnt, but they can get cuts from the knives.

I started doing this at the age of 4 thanks to my brother who was already involved in it. Now my inspiration comes from my uncle who has been three times world champion of fire dance.
